HELFORD ROAD '3G' MUGA CONDITIONS OF HIRE

1. It is the responsibility of the person named as the hirer on the booking form to ensure that any goals used are properly erected and weighted down. We accept no responsibility for any accidents caused by misuse of equipment.
2. Clean sports shoes must be worn.
BOOTS/BLADES/STUDS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
3. Users must not climb or swing on the goals in anyway or misuse any of the equipment.
4. The whole of the site is no smoking.
5. Animals must not be taken into the facility.
6. Spectators should stand on the **OUTSIDE** of the facility to avoid damage to pitches through unsuitable footwear.
7. **No food or drink is allowed in the facility, especially chewing gum.**
8. There must be a responsible adult in the facility at all times.
9. The facility is available for booking from 9:00am till 9.25pm. Each session will last 55 minutes, users must not enter the facility prior to their booked time of use, and must vacate the facility promptly at the end of their session.
10. Should for any reason, the pitch be unavailable for use, we will endeavor to contact the hirer prior to the time of their booking to advise them. In this instance a refund or deduction from their invoice shall be made.
11. Where bookings are made for the use of participants aged 16 & under a responsible adult must be present at all times during the use of the facility. The responsible adult should sign below to confirm this.
12. Peterlee Town Council reserve the right to cancel/change bookings.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERSON NAMED TO ENSURE THAT THE ABOVE CONDITIONS ARE ADHERED TO BY ALL PARTICIPANTS. IF THEY ARE NOT, THEN ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY OR ASKED TO LEAVE THE FACILITY.

Any damage caused to the pitch or equipment caused by not observing these rules and regulations will result in the main hirer being charged for repair, the resulting repair cost shall be charged to the main hirer as detailed in the booking form. There shall be no exceptions to this.
