(i) MUGA - Peterlee Helford FC Under 18's, Thursday Evenings

The Deputy Town Clerk advised that the Sports Development Officer had given her advice on this request reporting that no concessionary use was agreed for any Team using the MUGA at peak times and other requests had been refused. She suggested that her support could be offered to the Team to seek funding to help support them financially and or they could use the MUGA during off peak hours when the charge was reduced by 50%.
