43. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Details of a planning applications received were reported, as follows:-

Siting of cabin accommodation for recycled clothing bank (retrospective)
- (ii) 54 Berwick Chase
Erection of two storey side extension to side & retention of canopy to the front

- (iii) Mahals Indian Restaurant, 5 Durham Way
Change of use from restaurant to hot food takeaway
